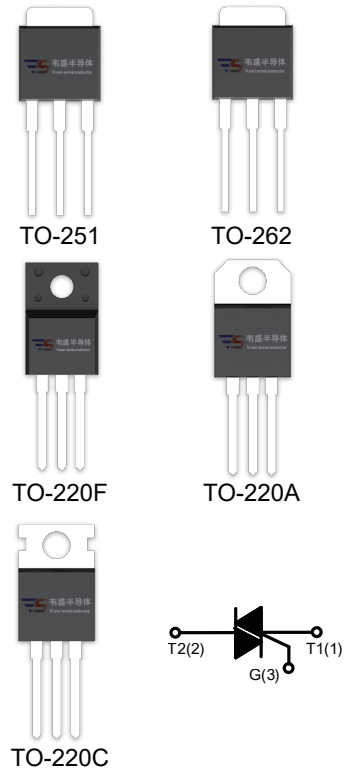


DESCRIPTION:

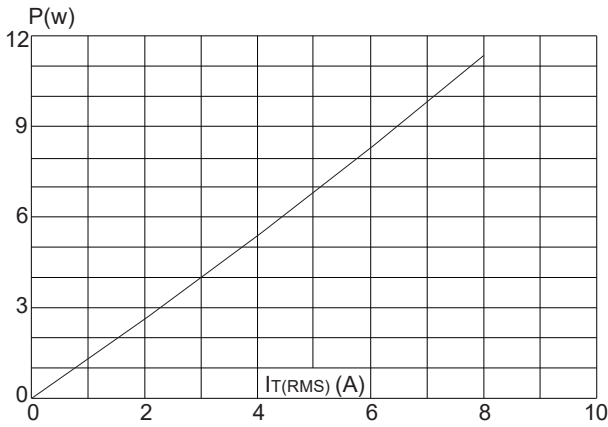
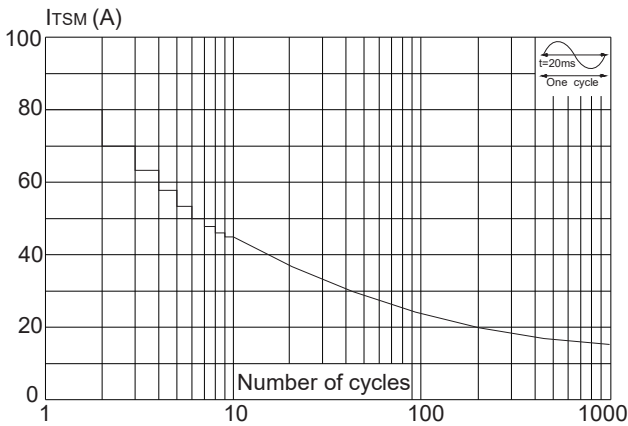
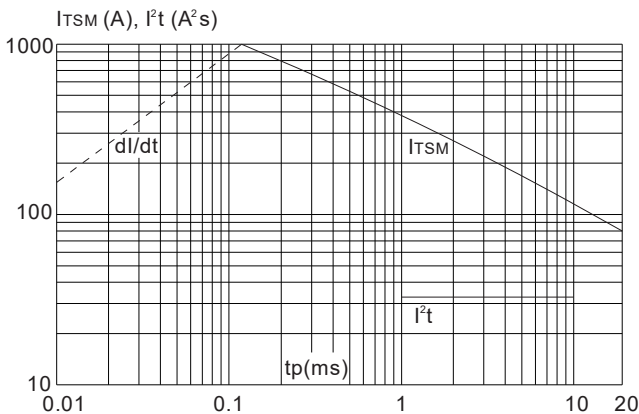
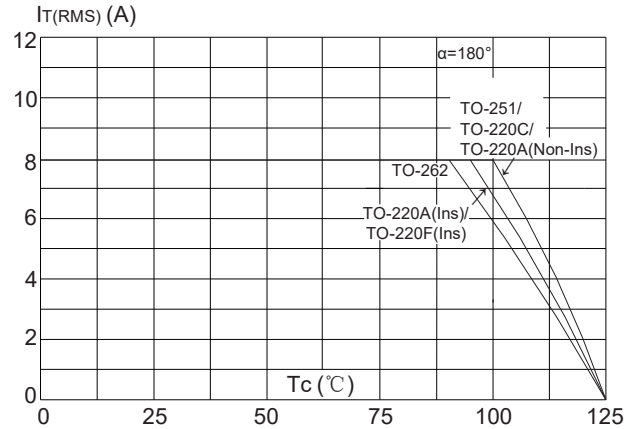
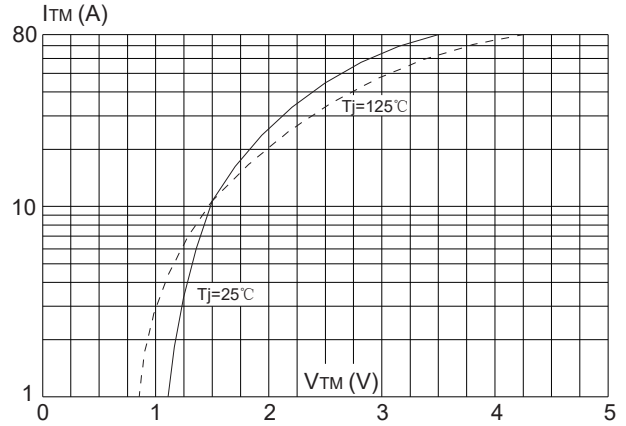
